**When?** Mon., June 8 - Fri., June 12, 9:00am– 4:00pm

**Where?** A.G. Rhodes Wesley Woods at 1819 Clifton Road NE, Atlanta 30329.

**How Much?** The cost is \$100 per student which includes meals and snacks, a t-shirt, a field trip, all expenses associated with volunteer projects, and an end-of-camp party.

### REQUIREMENTS

Rising ninth through twelfth graders may apply. Teens must be available for the duration of the camp. Teens who are 18 years old must also complete and pass a criminal background check.
