MATERIALS

- Boxes or Containers
- Art Supplies
- Baby lotion or rash cream
- Pacifier or teething toy
- Washcloth and towel
- Baby soap
- Baby toy
- Blanket

CONVERSATION STARTERS

- What are some things you do to care for yourself?
- How do you feel during and after an episode of self-care?
- Why do you think it is important for mothers and caregivers to have access to supplies that help them care for and clean their babies?

START A RIPPLE OF GIVING

- Reflect back on how your parents or caregivers have cared for you throughout the years to help you grow and how the care you've received made you feel.

DIRECTIONS

1. Gather the items — all items donated in the Mini-Me Kit must be new and unopened to ensure sanitary conditions for the babies and caregivers who will receive these kits. There is no specific store or brand required for the kits, so please feel free to shop around.
2. Decorate the box or container — get creative and play around with fun and colorful designs.
3. Write a note of encouragement — show your support and make someone's day!
4. Fill the boxes/containers with your items.
